

## Portfolio Requirements

- Name (first & last) & class period in box in bottom right corner
- First name in illustrations clearly representing letters
  - Letters should represent you (interests, hobbies, skills, etc.)
  - Objects are given new meaning as letters
  - Letters should be recognizable at first glance
  - Uses the elements of art in a neat & thought out manner

## Brainstorming

- Make a list of at least 7 things that interest you
  - Sports, Fashion, Music, Etc.
- For each of the things that interest you think about different objects you associate with it
  - Bat, Makeup Compact, Music Note
- Think about how you may be able to transform that object into a letter of your name
  - Ex: bat + ball = ic

## Narrowing it Down

- Once you've decided on some things you like & might be able to transform into a letter of your name make a sketch of each letter / object
- Begin drawing your objects on your portfolio
  - Pencil first
  - Then colored pencil

## Check Your Work & Add Details

- Check your work
  - All required text?
  - Each letter is represented by another object that represents you as a person?
  - Letters can be recognized at first sight?
  - All objects use multiple elements of art (including: value, color, & form)
  - IS IT NEAT & COMPLETE?
  - Complete artist's statement / project review
- Add a background or any additional designs or details you want...
