

Pop Art Project Checklist & Rubric

You must research a pop artist & create a display about the artist & their artwork
- Research:
 - Name & date of birth/death & photo of artist
 - Significant features of artist / artwork
 - What color pallet did they use?
 - What kinds of images / art did they make?
 - Why were they significant/ what are thy known for?
 - How would you describe their style?
 - 3 Artworks (image, title, date)
 - What is special or significant about this work?
 - What does it feature?
- Onomatopoeia Mini-Project
 - Write it large & in caps & outline it
 - Add explosion / cloud shapes behind it
 - Fill the negative space using primary colors, use ben-day dots & lines
- Artist Statement (see handout)
- Response to Art (see handout)
- Pop Art Project
 - Brainstorm objects, people, actions, styles, ideas, etc. that are popular now!
 - Use & combine ideas you brainstormed to create 2 sketches of possible final art project related to current pop culture (show color pallet on sketch you plan to use)
 - Begin drawing your final draft
 - Remember to use the Lichtenstein comic book style, bold lines, basic color pallet, & ben-day dots
